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CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: First item on the agenda this evening is Eagle Bay. Dave, you got any?

MR. ZIGLER: I think at the workshop, we went over the legal descriptions and who gets what. I think out of that whole deal, we're going to provide a description of it, that 50-foot right of way from the north end of the site to the battlefield. The rest of the descriptions for the public access and things, that's been provided.

And I believe that there was some discussion on fees, on maintenance of the landscaping and scheduling that was going to be provided to the Town. And we had a cost estimate. The cost estimate for public improvements on-site, and a cost estimate for the improvements off-site.

And then we're in the Health Department for water. The United Water, or Suez Water, or whatever their new name is, they approved the upgrading of the line from Reservoir Road to Orchard. That's off-site, water line

### 1 Proceedings 2 upgrading, upsizing. And then they also 3 approved the water main from the intersection 4 of Beach into the site. And then out through 5 the trestle to loop it. 6 The sewer was the Town's. We just got 7 the form. We are going to submit that. And 8 Liz at the Health Department said she would 9 review both at the same time. 10 The other outstanding issue would be 11 after final, we would have to get a road 12 permit for access to the Beach Road. 13 though there is access, when you do 14 construction on it, you have to get a permit 15 for it. 16 CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: Right. 17 MR. ZIGLER: So we are doing 18 improvements, as you know. We're doing a 19 curb, and so on and so forth. That requires 20 a permit. And of course, the traffic light 21 at that intersection, which was approved by 2.2 the County, but that has to be permitted 23 also. 24 CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: Right.

MR. ZIGLER: And then I believe we

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talked about the phasing. And we discussed the phasing of the promenade and that public access, that we didn't want to have public access to the front of the site when there was really heavy construction going on. So there was a discussion of going to the third building, and it would have to be finished, and the fourth. And then we have other clickers, as you might say, for other improvements like the traffic light. And all that's built into the plans.

The biggest thing was Note 18, which had to do with, I think the code is 92.3, marina. And there's a list of items that a marina may have. And a lot of these, we did want, and items that we did want. And so we had to put that note on, like, a comment response. Put that note on the map.

And then if we didn't want it, we said that that wouldn't be part of the approval, like fixing boats, or launching boats, all that. We don't -- it's not part of the deal. Storage of boats.

So, and then the things we wanted, we

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2	put that we wanted that. A pumping station
3	for the boats. A seasonal pumping station.
4	And then we put it where you could find it on
5	the maps.
6	So that's Note 18, and it's we
7	actually had to go into the second page. I
8	sent the revised maps in, but I my own
9	fault. There's a couple of items we did not
10	revise. I had it revised on my comment
11	response, but we hadn't done it on the maps.
12	So we have a couple of those things we have
13	to clean up.
14	And that was about it. If you have any
15	questions, or
16	CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: Max, you got?
17	MR. ZIGLER: things, or?
18	MR. STACH: Not at this point, no. I
19	think we're just going to look at the
20	submissions as they come in.
21	CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: All right. And John,
22	you looked at the map?
23	MR. O'ROURKE: Yeah. As Dave said, they
24	submitted a revised map. We also they
25	also submitted a revised construction cost

#### 1 Proceedings 2 estimate, so our office has been doing that. 3 And you know, generally, we're looking at 4 final notes. Just crossing Is, dotting Ts. 5 CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: Okav. 6 MR. O'ROURKE: Or vice versa. So, yeah. 7 CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: All right. 8 MR. ZIGLER: You know, I should go over 9 the maps. We did put -- there was a 10 discussion about the gates at the end of the 11 promenade. So we have an emergency gate out 12 at the other end for the emergency access. 13 We used the same gate at the promenade. And 14 we put it behind the sidewalk, or actually in 15 front of the sidewalk so it doesn't block the 16 sidewalks. 17 CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: Okay. 18 MR. ZIGLER: One of the other things, it 19 was a comment from Max. He kept bugging me 20 about access from the parking lot down to the 21 promenade in the middle, not having to go all 22 the way around. So we did put a switchback 23 sidewalk in on the south side of the rec 24

building. It goes down. And then you got to

do a switchback so you don't have a steep

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2	slope. And then that goes to the promenade.
3	And then we, we skipped the next
4	building. So we're at Building 3 and 4. We
5	put a path going down there.
6	So now we have two access points that we
7	didn't have before. If that's fine, after
8	they look at it, we do have to make a slight
9	modification to landscaping, because we have
10	landscaping up against it. And I think we're
11	going to have to put a light where that
12	switchback is on the sidewalk, one of those
13	low lights that we have on the promenade,
14	just for the purpose of safety.
15	CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: Right. All right.
16	John Hager? Anything?
17	MR. HAGER: No, I don't have anything at
18	this time.
19	CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: All right. Amy, have
20	you got anything that you'd like to say?
21	MS. MELE: No, thank you, Mr. Chairman.
22	We're working cooperatively behind the
23	scenes. Steve and I will be speaking
24	tomorrow morning about finalizing some of the
25	documents. But the TAC meeting was very

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2	helpful. And we're hoping to be on for final	
3	next month.	
4	CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: All right. Thank you	
5	very much. Appreciate it.	
6	MS. MELE: Thank you. Have a nice	
7	night.	
8	CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: Thanks. Anybody else
