So we're proposing to fill the wetlands and redirect that excess water back to Wayne Avenue. We're doing that through the drainage system proposed on Sheet 2, which comprises of the catch basins and the 15-inch storm drain pipe, which will alleviate all

We have two variances for the lots. And since the last meeting for TAC, we have revised the plan to show the lot width for the right of way, the water size for the water main on McCarthy Circle. And there was another issue. Oh, the adjoining owners.

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Anybody else has any questions, that's pretty much the project, and that's what we propose to do.

CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: All right.

BOARD MEMBER BIEHLE: So you're putting septic in 23,000 square feet. The lot size big enough for that? Usually well and septic needs 45.

MR. HAGER: Subject to a review by the County Department of Health, they have separation standards between wells and septics. So that's something that the design engineer will address on the plans. And our engineer will give the cursory review. But the ultimate decision will be at the County Department of Health level. So I think you're going to want to see that they're, they have approved the concept plan before you give the final approval. And then their final plan review will be at the building permit level.

MR. O'ROURKE: To follow up on John's comment, they do have municipal water. It's just the septic system, and they've done I

believe some preliminary testing that would indicate that they could have a septic there. So basically, to cut to the chase, I think they're here this evening because officially, you have not done a site visit, or done any referrals, or anything on this application. So I think they're to a point now that we can probably start moving forward.

CHAIRMAN JOHNSON: Okay.

MR. O'ROURKE: Unless Sam says no, because I saw her just turn her microphone.
