

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
LOWLAND PARK FLOODING MITIGATION/ RETAINING WALL CONSTRUCTION

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that sealed proposals will be received by the Town of Stony Point Town Clerk at Town Hall located at 74 East Main Street, Stony Point, New York until 10AM local time on November 21, 2024 for "LOWLAND PARK FLOODING MITIGATION / RETAINING WALL CONSTRUCTION" and then at said office, publicly opened and read aloud.

SCOPE OF WORK: The work consists of installation of approximately 675 feet of mafia / bunker block along existing paved walkway, between the walkway and the stream. The wall is to be buried minimum 6 inches below grade and placed on 6 inches of gravel subbase. The wall is to extend to Lowland Park Bridge with no gaps. Minimum weight of block is 3,500 lbs. Exact location to be coordinated with the Town Highway Superintendent at the time of installation. Disturbed areas to be seeded and hayed as necessary at completion of construction.

Information for Bidders, Specifications, and Contract Documents for the proposed work are on file and can be reviewed and copy obtained from the Town Clerk's Office in Town of Stony Point Town Hall located at 74 E. Main Street, Stony Point, New York between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday beginning October 17, 2024 and concluding at November 21, 2024. A pre-bid meeting will be held at 10:00 AM on November 7, 2024 at Charles Eccher / Lowland Park located on Lowland Hill Road, Stony Point, New York 10980.

All bidders are required to familiarize themselves with the existing conditions and proposed improvements prior to submitting the sealed proposal in accordance with this Advertisement for Bids.

This project is being funded in whole or in part with Federal Assistance provided to the County of Rockland by the U.S. Department of Treasury under the American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA Funds"), *Section 602(b) and 603(b) of the Social Security Act, Pub. L. No. 117-2 (March 11, 2021)* and is subject to certain requirements including *2 CFR Part 200, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards*. Applicable Federal requirements take precedence over State and local requirements unless State and local requirements are deemed to be more stringent.

Please note that one of the qualifications for determining whether or not a business entity is a "responsible bidder" when Federal funding is involved is that the Contractor **must** have a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) **and** an active registration with the United States General Services Administration (USGSA). The UEI and registration are obtained at www.SAM.gov. All vendors, contractors/subcontractors, consultants/subconsultants, etc., must be registered in the Federal system and continue to maintain an active SAM.gov registration with current information, at all times during the period of performance and must have the standing to receive federal awards. Contracts cannot be signed without an active registration with SAM.gov.

Prevailing wages established under the Davis-Bacon Act will apply to this contract. All bidders will need to sign and notarize that they agree to this and other applicable requirements for the expenditure of Federal funds in the Federal Clauses Form included with bid documents.

The Town of Stony Point reserves the right to reject any and all bids and/or to accept any proposal which meets the criteria herein and in the opinion of the Town of Stony Point is in the best interest of the residents of the Town of Stony Point.

All bidders must be licensed to do business within the State of New York. Out-of-state bidders must be registered with the Secretary of State.

Submissions from all bidders are required to contain a certification of non-collusion bidding pursuant to Section 103d of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.
