Town of Stony Point Sewage Treatment Plant Expansion Fact Sheet

What is the Proposed Project?

The Proposed Project will increase the treatment capacity of the Town of Stony Point Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) from 1.0 million gallons per day (MGD) to 1.8 MGD and expand components of the treatment plant. To implement the proposed project, the Town of Stony Point has submitted an application for a SPDES permit to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) to increase the flow capacity of the plant. The purpose of this fact sheet is to inform the public about the proposed project and to involve the community during the NYSDEC permit application review process.

Why does the Town of Stony Point need to increase the treatment capacity and expand components of the plant?

The Town currently operates the STP on North Street at a permitted flow of 1.0 million gallons per day (MGD) with the treated effluent being discharged into the Hudson River. The Town entered into an intermunicipal agreement (IMA) with the Haverstraw Joint Regional Sewerage Board (HJRSB) in 2005 to allow the diversion of up to a daily flow of 700,000 gallons of untreated sewage. The agreement is set to expire on July 5, 2025. The disconnection from HJRSB may only occur if the existing Stony Point STP has been evaluated and expanded to treat the previously diverted flow. The Stony Point STP's SPDES Permit must be modified, and the plant must be able to accommodate the existing, diverted, and proposed future flows. This project will not increase the flow within the municipality, it will just allow it to be treated within the Town at the STP.

How might the project affect the surrounding community?

The expansion is crucial for the proper treatment of wastewater as a result of the IMA expiring July 2025. This will enable the Town of Stony Point Sewage Treatment Plant to be self-sufficient and treat the incoming flow without diversion of sewage to HJRSB. The expansion of the plant will allow more efficient treatment and upgrade the plant with newer equipment.

Some potential impacts are but not limited to:

Increase in noise and traffic during construction of the newly expanded sewage plant.
